

Pastoral Support Package

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Aim: To provide an unbiased evaluation of the performance and standards of pastoral care

Support provided:

1. Planning and Preparation (1 day)

Analysis of school systems and structures for pastoral care. Review of relevant school policies, inspection or monitoring reports, attendance and exclusion data. Independent reviewer will also undertake a parental survey.

2. School Visit (1 day)

Review of pastoral care to include meetings with link member of SLT and other key individuals who hold posts linked to pastoral care. This will also include interviews with members of the support staff, pupil panel interviews and a meeting with cross section on parents, identified prior to the visit.

3. Follow up meeting (½ day)

Share findings with Headteacher and member of SLT with responsibility for pastoral care. Agree key areas for improvement and provide guidance on updating SIP to reflect any changes in key priorities.

Outcomes:

- School leaders are able to make secure judgements on the quality of pastoral care
- Clear recommendations are made to support future improvements
- SIP clearly identifies school improvement priorities for pastoral care
