SMSC Review

Aim: To audit the provision of Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural across the school. To raise attainment and progress through promote SMSC outcomes for pupils.

Support provided:

1. Planning and Preparation (½ day)

Analysis of audit detailing provision across the school. A review of the SMSC policy and documentation.

2. School Visit (1 day)

Reviewer will work with school leaders to identify gaps in existing provision and identify key areas for SMSC development. The visit will include a review of teaching and learning in the classrooms and an interview with a panel of pupils to evaluate the quality of the provision.

3. Report (½ day)

This will outline key recommendations for further improving the way the school promotes SMSC outcomes for its pupils and the impact this can have on raising their achievement

Outcomes:

- School leaders are able to make secure judgements on the quality of SMSC provision.
- Clear recommendations are made to support future improvements in SMSC and develop plans in relation to school improvement priorities and/or inspection reports
